How to Go

Plotting a Pack Trial schedule can be more daunting than the actual trip. Here's a sample itinerary to use as a guide. Last year, I flew into San Diego and worked my way north; just reverse the schedule to travel north to south, flying into San Jose or San Francisco. There's no benefit to either direction. I usually alternate from year to year for variety's sake. The real juggling act is making sure the trials can accommodate me when I want to visit.
