Monrovia CEO Stepping Down After 40 Years

Monrovia Nursery Company announced that Miles Rosedale will step down from his role as CEO, but remain Co-Chairman of the Board of Directors. The move was effective December 31, 2020. Monrovia's Board has initiated a search for a new CEO and the company will remain family- owned.
