In other AmericanHort news, the association has announced that they'll be providing management services to the Ohio Nursery Landscape Association (ONLA). AmericanHort President and CEO Ken Fisher will serve as Executive Director. He'll help ONLA set organizational priorities and resources and help with resource optimization, staff coaching and development, and accomplishment of overall association goals.

AmericanHort says they have nearly a decade of experience providing management services to other national and state associations, such as the Nursery and Landscape Association Executives (NLAE) of North America.
